

Point System:

A maximum of 10 points may be won for each playoff game, based on these criteria:
 Score differential must be kept to 5 (so 5-0, 6-1, 7-2 are OK).

Win	6	
Tie	3	
Goal Scored	1	(Max 3)
Shutout	1	
Missed Ref assignment	-3	
Unsporting behavior	-1	
Exceed 5 Goal Difference	-1	for each goal beyond difference of 5 (6-0 = -1 point; 7-0 = -2 points)

Missed referee assignments may disqualify a team from participating in league play through.

Tie Breaker:

At the end of the of the playoff round robin, teams will be ranked according to the total points they have won (see above).

If 2 or more teams have the same number of points, the following tie breakers will be used in the order listed.
 (These tie breakers only consider playoff game results; regular season friendlies are not counted.)

- (1) head-to-head competition (the outcome of the games involving the tied teams);
- (2) greatest goal differential (total goals scored, less goals allowed, **with a maximum goal differential of five per game**);
- (3) least goals allowed (the total of all goals scored against the tied teams);
- (4) most goals scored (**but goals scored in a game beyond a goal differential of 5 don't count**)

If teams are still tied after considering all of these tie breakers, we will use penalty kicks as the final tie breaker.
 However, if just 2 teams are tied for 1st or 3rd place, they will automatically play in the final round. Penalty kicks are not needed.

Penalty Kicks:

If somehow there are 2 or more teams still tied after considering the 4 tie breakers above:

1. The teams will gather at a designated time and place.
2. The teams will draw random seeds.
3. The teams will match up in penalty kick contests according to the seeded order.
4. Teams losing a penalty kick contest are eliminated from 1st place in the penalty kick contests.
5. The team winning all of its contests is the 1st place winner.
6. The order of finish of the other teams is as shown here:
